Going In and Out

For your safety only allow known people into Shalom House

There is a board in the entryway with apartment numbers that visitors use to buzz you. You must first press the "Talk" button to ask who is outside. Press the "Door" button to let the resident in ONLY if you know who is outside.

Disposing of Trash

Boxes should be flattened and thrown in the Trash bins located outside on the north side of the building.

Small wrapped or tied bags of trash can be disposed of in the Trash Chutes located on the north and south side of the front halls. Boxes or raw garbage must be taken to the trash bin.

Recycling Center is located behind Shalom House through the east doors on the first floor.
